Michael Rochford, Executive Director, St. Nicks Alliance

Michael Rochford holds a Masters of City and Regional Planning from Pratt Institute and an MBA in Finance from Pace University. He has served in a variety of posts at St. Nicks Alliance and is currently its Executive Director. He oversees the organization, including its several partner entities. Since becoming Executive Director, he has launched Youth, Civic Anchor, Elder Care, and expanded Workforce Development, as well as nonprofit affordable housing development strategies. Michael has organized many of St. Nicks Alliance's affiliated organizations and, in 2006 and 2013, led the mergers with three organizations, integrating after-school, childcare, community center, and senior center services while rebuilding vital community facilities. He provided leadership in implementing St. Nicks' Transformational Framework, unified all activities, and has been a thought leader in creating resident-focused, impactful, and measurable services.

Michael is the founder of several NYC-wide nonprofit consortia, including Joint Operating Entity – JOE NYC, which is strengthening community-based affordable housing asset management and building nonprofit sector capacity to expand the supply of affordable housing. He was the founder of Community Home Care Consortium, which is building effectiveness in community-based home care by integrating services into the community network.
